Keep our marina clean. This time of year we get the occasional fuel / oil spill into the water while people are getting their boats ready for spring. It is extremely important to understand that accidents happen, but need to be reported, so appropriate action can be taken. As a reminder, times to be particularly careful are: fueling, oil changes, any engine service. If your boat has been unattended for any length of time, look in your bilge when you get on the boat to confirm it is clean. When your bilge pump comes on, look over the side to make sure the water is clean. Don't be afraid to report an accident, it is cheaper to deal with it immediately.

Pleasant Harbor Yacht Club and Marina Spring Recycling, Re-Use, Re-Purpose Event

Saturday, April 26, 2008 until 3 pm. This is a joint effort between the marina and the Yacht Club. This is a great opportunity to do some early spring cleaning and dispose of (safely and properly) unneeded, old items or trade/swap/give-away items that may be of use to someone else!

Go through your boat and your dock box, pull out stuff like old paints, batteries, solvents, boards, carpet pieces, and the other stuff that is no longer needed. If there are items that are useable, then set them out on the upper deck by the pool as part of a swap meet activity. If there are items that can be recycled, then bring them up to the lower parking lot for sorting and packaging between the hours of 11:00 and 2pm. What is accepted for disposal into garbage dumpsters (marina dumpsters are for marina tenant's boat waste ONLY)

All residential and commercial solid waste including refrigerators and other appliances except for the following items:

- MRW Hazardous Waste, hazardous waste
- Small Quantity Generators, hazardous waste from businesses
- Asbestos and asbestos containing waste
- Free liquids—must be solidified and non-hazardous

Moderate risk wastes (MRW) are common house and garden cleaners, chemicals, and auto products that may be hazardous to store and dangerous to you, your family, and the environment. MRW is either flammable, corrosive, reactive, toxic, or a combination of these characteristics. In general, any product labeled with the words **Caution, Warning, Danger, Toxic, or Poison** can be considered hazardous. Disposal of this type of waste in your garbage is prohibited by State and County regulations.

Proper methods to dispose of various items:

Used Oil Filters: puncture filter and drain for 48 hours, put in a plastic garbage bag, tie put in a second plastic garbage bag, tie bag closed and dispose into garbage dumpster.

Anti Freeze: empty container into barrel permanently located between the North restrooms and the fuel yard marked "Anti Freeze".

Used engine oil: empty container into barrel permanently located between the North restrooms and the fuel yard marked "Waste Oil".

Large or bulky items: Contact the marina store prior to putting any large items in the dumpster.

For April 26th ONLY...

Batteries: Bring to the lower parking lot

Diesel and gasoline: Bring your small quantities in your fuel containers to the lower parking lot.

Items available for reuse: Anything that could be reused (solvents, paint, line, ?) bring to pool area to the swap meet. Hazardous waste not reused at the swap meet will be taken along with other items taken to the lower parking lot to be properly disposed of.

Large items for disposal: Bring to the lower parking lot, they will be taken to large dumpster in upper parking lot.

ALL other items: Greg and Diane will direct to the appropriate drop off area.

Jefferson County residents can take materials free of charge to the Moderate Risk Waste Facility, located at 282 10th St., inside the Port's Industrial Park, directly across from McDonald's. Current hours are Friday and Saturday, from 10-4:30 PM, except for public holidays. Please call ahead with any questions or concerns...360-379-6911. During business hours when the facility is closed, call Jefferson County Public Works...360-385-9160.
